Did You Know...

Wisconsin was the eighth state to have a Kiwanis club. That was the Kiwanis Club of Milwaukee, organized on October 24, 1916. Racine became the second on November 24, 1916, followed by Madison, February 5, 1917; Kenosha, April 25, 1917; Fond du Lac, August 11, 1917; Green Bay, October 3, 1917 and Oshkosh, November 1, 1917.

These seven clubs formed the nucleus for the Wisconsin District of Kiwanis International when it was formed on September 24, 1918. Upper Michigan was added to the Wisconsin District on November 27, 1920 to form the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan District we know today, less the three easternmost counties of the UP which were returned to the Michigan District in 1935 because of distance and winter travel conditions.
