This will help prevent one-sided political campaigning to our membership without the opportunity of rebuttal by challengers.

Board Meeting

Treasurer’s report: Administrative \$7,261.33. Community Service \$15,123.15. In other business, the Board approved membership for Jewell Garrison; accepted the resignation of Jim Catania with regret and denied general fund request from Inspiration Ministries. The Board also tabled the Kiwanis First Lady Project (pediatric bags) and tabled fund requests from Delavan-Darien School District for Automatic External Defibrillators (AED’s) and from Kiwanis International Foundation. The Board approved funds for Rock and Read (“Wings and a Halo”) and discussed the Walworth County Adult Guardianship Program. The Board also released funds for the six Elkhorn Kiwanis scholarships (budgeted) to be awarded on June 4th. The next board meeting will be on Thursday April 3rd at St. John’s.
