Board Meeting

Treasurer’s report: Administrative \$7,483.10. Community Service \$14,027.33. In other business, the Board approved funds for Project Graduation (budgeted); denied fund request from Delavan-Darien School District for Automatic External Defibrillators (AED’s) and tabled the Kiwanis First Lady Project (pediatric bags). The Board also discussed and tabled cystic fibrosis fund raiser and Elkhorn Chamber 4th of July booth participation. The Board discussed and clarified the Kiwanis Annual Gift Giving Campaign from Kiwanis International Foundation, WI-UP District and the Annual Governor’s Gift, approving funds for each. The Board approved funds for a local children’s book drive to ship books to children in Uganda. The Board also agreed to purchase two Spiral Wishing Wells for fund raising.
