Treasurer’s report: Administrative \$3041.91. Community Service \$6200.46. In other business, the Board approved budgeted money for Project Graduation and for two campers to attend Camp Wawbeek, waiving the normal registration fee for one camper. The Board also discussed: donation request from Vocational Industries; profit (or lack thereof) from St. Patty’s Day luncheon; and agreed to still hold our regular meeting Monday following the Honors Night Banquet.
