## Board Meeting

Treasurer's report: Administrative \$204.77 - Community Service \$13,491.60. In other business, the Board approved splitting the cost for the purchase of a portable oxygen unit for a student at Lakeland School, pending further investigation. Total cost for the unit is \$525 which the Club will pay \$275. This led to discussion and subsequent approval to create a "Good Samaritan" budget line item for special requests such as this. This will be initially funded in part using Builders Club monies and ongoing special raffles. The Board also approved an initial budget of \$1100 for the Fit-for-Life Run Committee to be used at their discretion for the race. Expenses will be reported monthly to the Board. Next board meeting: Thursday January 5<sup>th</sup> at St. Johns.
